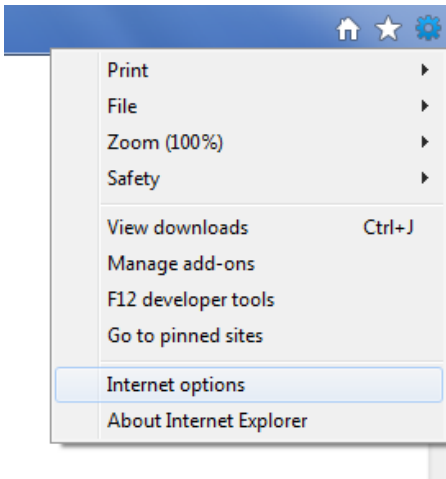


Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client Instructions for partner connections to AHCCCS systems.

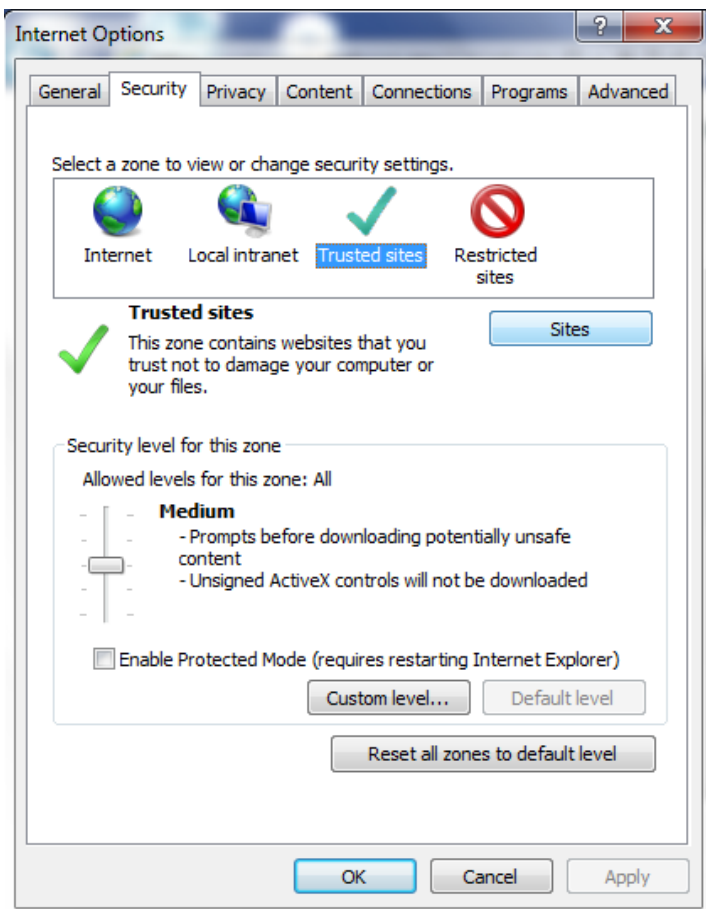
The instructions below are for Internet Explorer. Other browsers are supported for this connection, but the steps may differ.

Open Internet Explorer

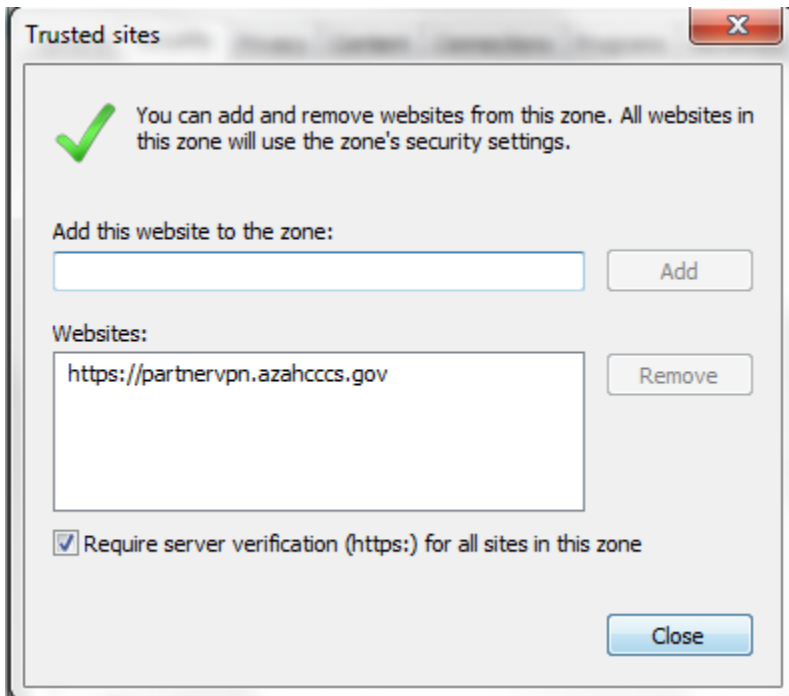
Open Internet Options



Click on the Security Tab, click on Trusted sites, then click the Sites button

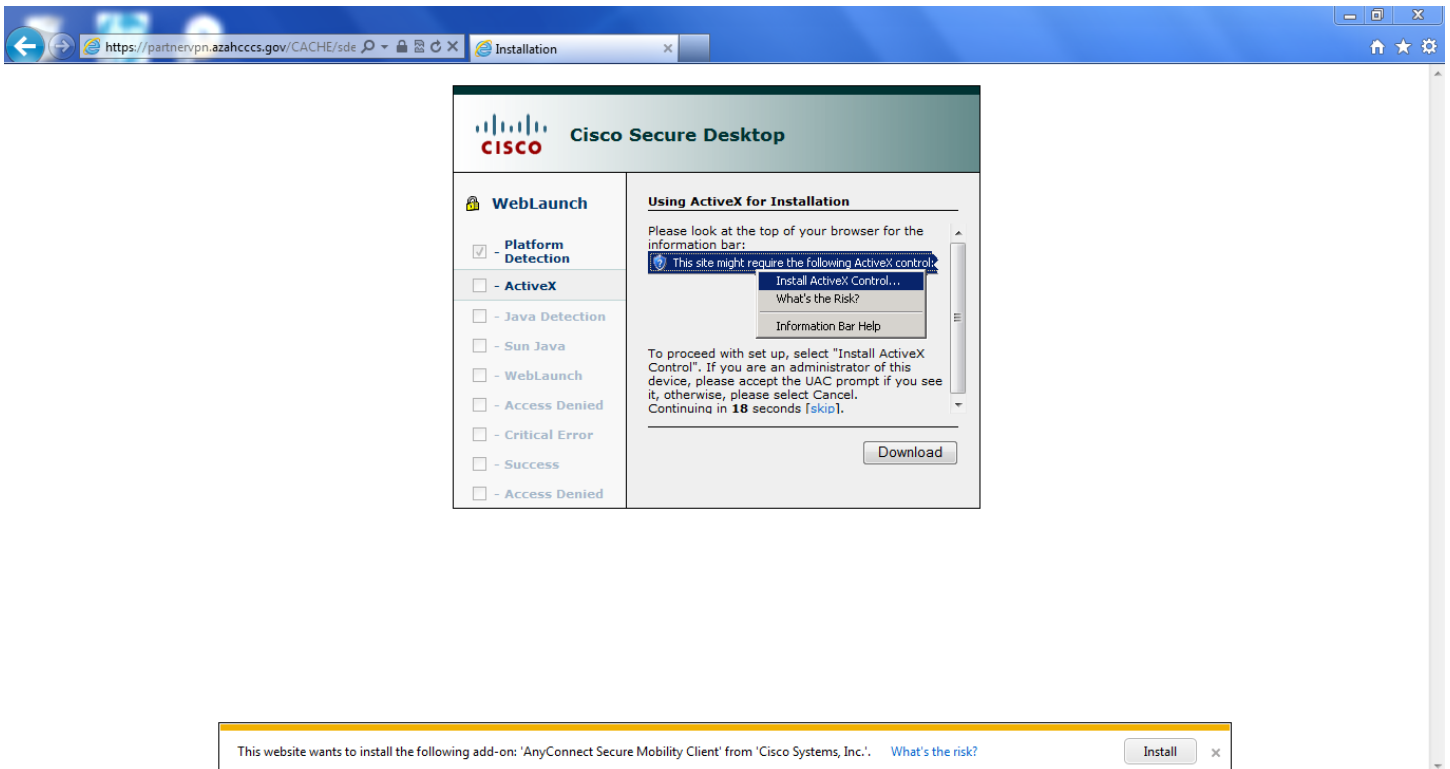


Type <https://partnervpn.azahcccs.gov> into the box and click add. Click Close when finished.

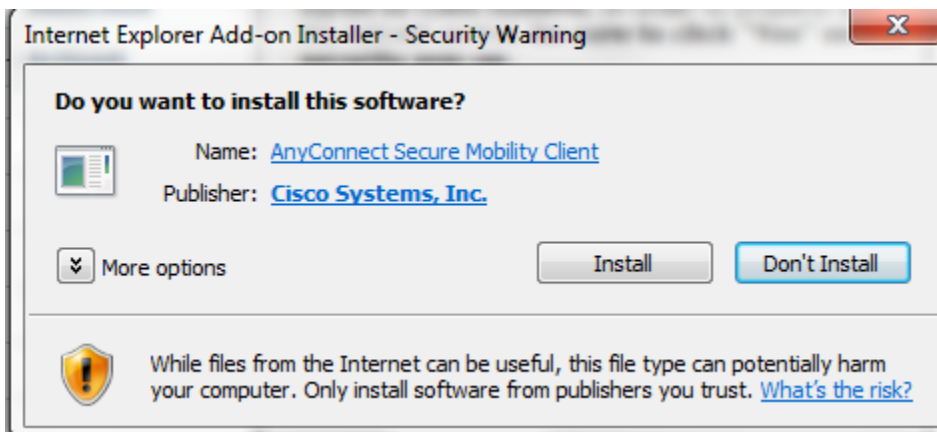


Click OK to close out of the Internet Options dialog box.

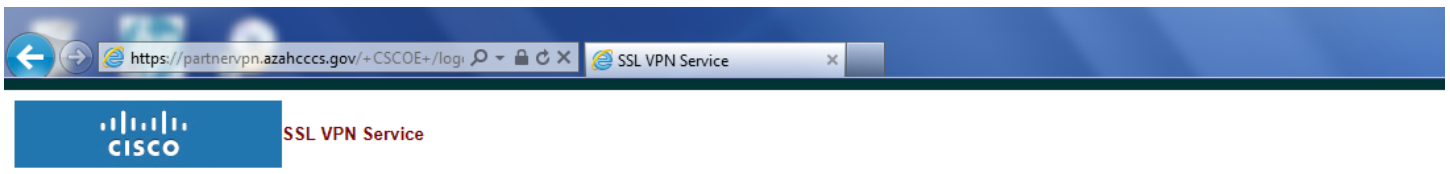
In the address bar, navigate to <https://partnervpn.azahcccs.gov>. You will be asked to install an add-on. Click Install to allow the application.



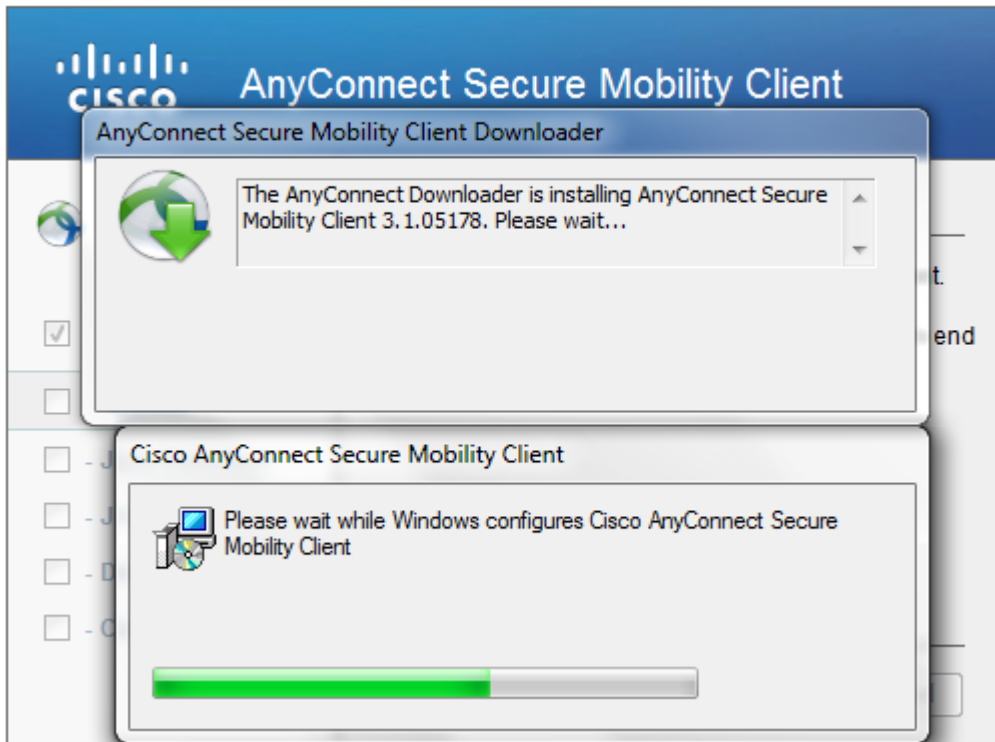
When the Security Warning box comes up, click Install. (You may be prompted by the Windows UAC if enabled on your system)



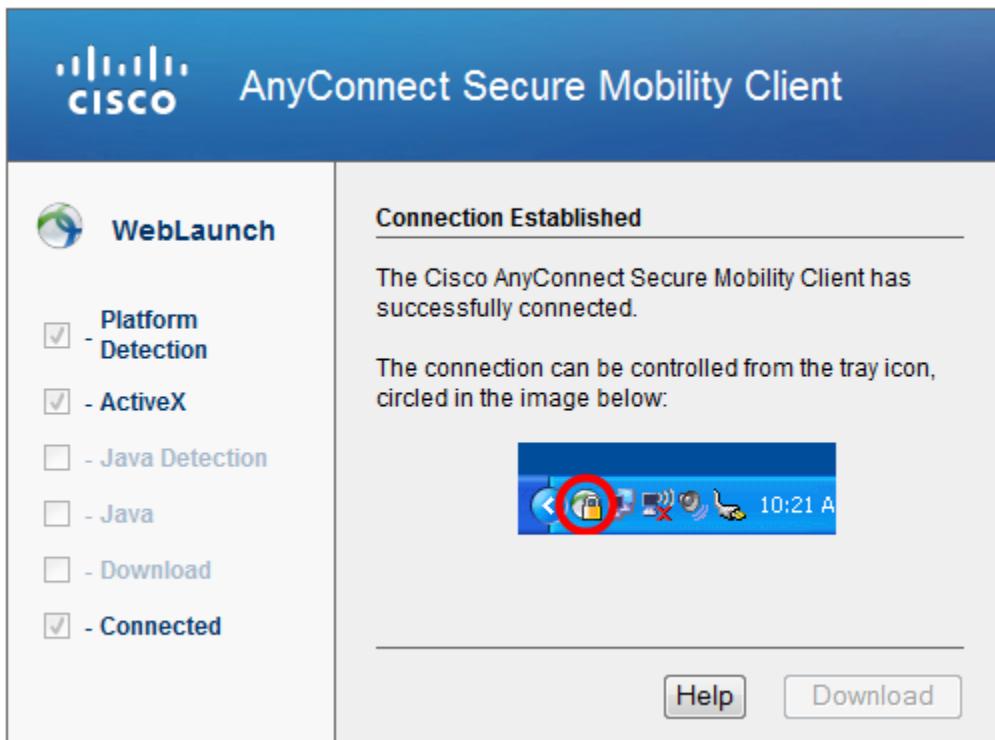
After the install process is complete, you should see the following screen. Enter your login credentials and click Login.
